Tips for a Clean & Fresh Community


Living in an apartment offers unique conveniences, but with shared spaces, cleanliness becomes a collective effort. Here's how you can help keep our community spotless and hygienic:

Mastering Balcony Etiquette

Let's delve into key pointers for understanding balcony etiquette within your apartment community.

Do's 🗸

- Do keep your balcony in good condition and free from hazards.
- Do conduct regular inspections for signs of damage or deterioration.
- Do adhere to community guidelines for maintaining your balcony.
- Do seek prior approval for any significant alterations or structural modifications.
- Do regularly clean your balcony drainage and open it during rains.
- Do refrain from storing flammable liquids like petrol/diesel or household materials, and children's toys.

Don'ts 🍑

- Don't throw cigarette butts and ashes from the balconies.
- Don't barbecue and use shisha on balconies, as they pose potential fire hazards.
- Don't throw waste and sharp objects from balconies.
- Don't store large items like sofas or cupboards.
- Don't hang clothes, towels, or decorative items in your balcony.
- Don't leave your children and pets unattended in the balcony.
- Don't cover your balcony with safety screens, awnings, pergolas, curtains or shades.

If you encounter any concerns or issues with balconies, don't hesitate to report them to the community management team for resolution.





Prevent Mosquito Infestation

Eliminate Stagnant Water

As responsible community members, it's crucial to understand the root cause of increased mosquito infestation. Stagnant water is the main reason for this rise in pests and related health issues. Let's focus on eliminating stagnant water and taking proactive measures to safeguard our collective well-being.

Why is stagnant water a concern?



Breeding ground for mosquitoes/pests



Poses serious health risks to all residents



Foul odour and aesthetic issues




Degrades water quality



Prioritising Community Health

We are proactively conducting several treatments such as ULV treatments, Larvicide Chemical (IGR) treatments, Thermal Fogging, Rodent Bait Services, Residual Spray near the lakes, water bodies, and common areas. Despite our continuous efforts, pest infestations persist due to stagnant water in individual properties.



Together For A Healthier, Happier Community!

- Check and clear clogged gutters, containers holding rainwater, and unused pools or ponds.
- Install mesh screens or covers on rain barrels and water storage containers to deter mosquitoes.
- Empty containers like flowerpots, buckets, and children's toys that collect water.
- Inspect your garden area for water accumulation caused by drip irrigation, rainwater or excessive watering of plants.
- Washing cars can lead to water pooling on pavements. Clean your car in your private carport using a damp cloth. Use waterless, eco-friendly cleaning products.



Water Heater Maintenance

Keep your water heater safe and efficient with these quick tips:

General Tips

Power Off First: Always disconnect before maintenance.

Monthly Valve Check: Test and clean the safety valve; replace if needed.

Key Inspections

Heating Element: Clean or replace every two years. Thermostat: Replace if overheating or steaming.

Safety Valve: Inspect every two years.

Safe Practices

Check for leaks and secure wall hooks.

Never operate with wet hands.

Keep cold water flowing during heating.

Pro Advice

Use original spare parts.

Drain the heater if away for long periods.

A little maintenance goes a long way!



Bulky Waste Disposal

1 Keep it in Bounds

Place garbage bins within your villa's boundary walls, not in common areas.

2 Cleanliness is Key

Regularly clean your garbage bin and surrounding area for a fresher neighbourhood!

3 Odour Control Tip

Tightly tie garbage bags before binning to reduce unpleasant smells.

4 Recycle Weekly

Place recyclables next to your bin for weekly collection.

5 No Dumping Zone

Common areas are not for garbage or waste disposal - let's keep them clean!

6 Professional Pickup

Rely on our waste collection service provider for regular garbage removal.

7 Special Waste Alert

Construction debris and old furniture need proper disposal - not in shared spaces!



Safety Measures For Heavy Rainfall

We are taking all precautions to safeguard our community, however, it's vital to protect your property and belongings.



Fix Windows & Ceilings
Repair any damage to windows, roofs, or ceilings to prevent leaks.
Seal gaps with weatherproof caulking.

Secure Outdoor Furniture

Bring in or fasten outdoor furniture to avoid wind damage.

Prevent Moisture Damage

Hire professionals to inspect and seal vulnerabilities in your home to prevent leaks.

Check AC Systems
Service air conditioning units to ensure proper drainage and efficiency.

Stay safe, dry, and prepared!

Inspect Water Heaters
Check for leaks or corrosion and flush the tank to maintain efficiency.

Trim Plants

Keep garden plants trimmed to prevent blockages in drainage systems.

Park Safely

Avoid parking in low-lying or flood-prone areas and under trees.

Maintain Pool Levels

Lower pool water levels to prevent overflow during heavy rainfall.


